To build peer relationships across cultures and to learn and grow in fellowship while bringing hope and help to impoverished students and the guardian families caring for AIDS orphans.

WHEN: July 17-July 29, 2019

WHERE: Adziwa Christian School in Kauma village just outside Lilongwe, Malawi

COST: \$3600-\$3800 per person (costs include airfare, ground costs, transportation, supply fees and food while in Africa. Price may vary within this range based on airfare at time of ticketing)

_____ RSVP to our info meeting on January 27th. If you have serious interest about attending the trip, but cannot attend that meeting, please e-mail Matt at Matt@churchofthecity.com.

_____ From January 27th- February 14th we will open an a link to register for the trip. It will include paying a non-refundable \$500 deposit. (***Once we have your deposit, we lock you in to the team and purchase plane tickets with the typical rules and restrictions (i.e. non-refundable, non-transferable, fees to change, etc.) so you must be committed to cover that cost in full even if you aren't able to go for any reason.)

____ Get your passport, notarized guardianship permission form and birth certificate.

____ Plan for all necessary vaccinations. *Costs are approximate and NOT covered in your trip costs above.

- <u>Twinrix (combination of Hepatitis A & B)</u> \$126.00 for each of 3 shots given within 6 months (good for 25 years) – see website for details on getting Hep A & B separately
- TDaP (Tetanus, Diphtheria & Pertussis) \$60.00 (good for 5-10 years)
- <u>Typhoid shot</u> \$89.00 (good for 2 years) **or** a prescription for <u>Typhoid pills</u> (\$80-\$90 at a pharmacy, good for 5 years)
- <u>Adult Polio</u> \$50.00 (good for life)
- <u>Malaria pills</u> (cost varies significantly depending on the medicine prescribed)
